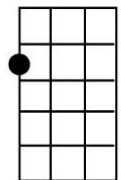
Intro: Am F C Em

And the [C] songs they get louder Each one better than be[Em]fore.

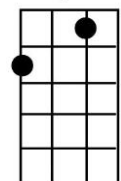

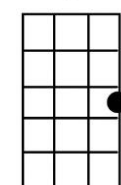

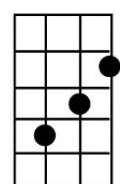
